Since 1998 Daniel has also been developing with his wife Jude, son Oscar and daughter Poppy a permaculture- organic farm and apiary on 5 acres overlooking the Kaipara Harbour at the Otamatea Eco Village. They have designed and built one of the first straw bale houses in the north plus an earth brick barn and a natural swimming pool.

Trish Allen:

Trish and her late husband Joe Polaischer founded the iconic, award-winning Rainbow Valley Farm in 1988 on permaculture principles and ethics. The farm inspired thousands of people over 25 years in sustainable living and demonstrated the principles of permaculture in action. Trish has now moved on and established a village-scale model of permaculture and shares her knowledge by teaching permaculture-related courses and workshops. Trish has a Diploma in Permaculture.
